

Exchange Forums and Practice Dialogue

A ProfilPASS in Preparation for Retirement

The transition from employment to retirement is an important and sometimes challenging phase of life. Retirement means that the gainful employment that structures everyday life no longer exists, so that a feeling of uselessness and underachievement can set in. To counteract this, it can be important to find alternative fields of activity. The new ProfilPASS offers users the opportunity to create a competence profile by systematically recording and documenting their competences and to recognize their own potential, even if it is still unknown. In this exchange forum, you will receive impulses from research on the different age images and the question of how to reach the target group in the recruitment of participants. In addition, a representative from adult education practice will explain how people at the beginning of retirement can be supported in their competence identification with the ProfilPASS.

B ProfilPASS for women – We can do it!

The new ProfilPASS version contributes to the assessment of competences and identification of strengths as well as the empowerment of women regarding (re)integration into the labour market. In this interactive exchange forum, get to know the different project materials that are intended to support counsellors in their work with women at risk of poverty. The focus will be on the dialogue between the ProfilPASS developers and a representative from the field, who will critically analyze the usability of the PP in concrete everyday counselling and discuss the factors for helpful counselling. All participants of the forum are invited to enrich this dialogue with their own experiences, but also with questions.
